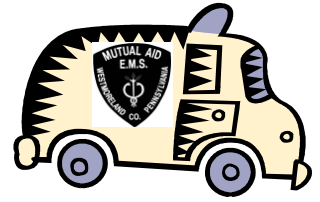

Emergency Medical Technician Course

- Classes are scheduled to run *Monday* and *Wednesday* evening from **6:00p – 10:00p**. You should wear comfortable, but appropriate clothing.
- This certification program is a two part certification process. First, the student will complete the Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) course and upon completion, will take a National Registry practical and written examination. Second part will be the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course and upon completion, will take a National Registry practical and computerized based test (CBT) examination.
- Additional course requirements outlined in the National EMS Education Standards such as Hazardous Materials Recognition and Identification; Incident Command System (ICS 100) and NIMS 700 certifications will need to be satisfied prior to the National Registry CBT examination for EMR and EMT. EMT's have an additional requirement of completing 10 patient contacts to be eligible for testing.
- Students less than 18 years of age must have a parental consent form signed to sit for PA-State exam and are not eligible to test until they are 16 years old.
- Accepted candidates will receive a letter of acceptance. Students must have the necessary mental acuity, practical skills, motivation, and mental attitude and must adhere to the physical performance guidelines as outlined in the Functional Position Description for the EMT-Basic. In addition, the candidates must possess the perseverance to provide quality patient care, even under difficult circumstances.
- **Tuition: EMR: \$200.00 / EMT \$275.00** (\$475.00) will be required the first day of the class and should be made payable to **Mutual Aid Ambulance Service** unless other arrangements have been made. Tuition includes EMT textbook and required State testing fees and a CPR pocket mask.
- *This program will provide you with the necessary certifications needed to meet the entry level requirements for employment in EMS.*
