National Registry Paramedic Refresher Course – SPRING 2018

COURSE PURPOSE

This course is for Paramedics to maintain their credentials at the NRP level or to be eligible to challenge the NRP written exam (CBT).

COURSE CONTENT

NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR Paramedic:

All NREMT-Paramedics who have expiration dates of March 31, 2011 or March 31, 2012 have two registration cycles (four years) to complete a state approved Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic to Paramedic transition course in order to be eligible for National EMS Certification as a Paramedic (NRP).

- Completion of a transition course that is state approved must be validated by attending and successfully completing a course that issues a certificate that has within its title:
 - NREMT-Paramedic's name
 - transition course completion date
 - The certificate must contain the following statement: "has completed a state approved EMT-Paramedic to Paramedic transition course."
 - name of the sponsoring agency
 - signature of the individual responsible for the training
- In order to transition to the Paramedic level, the NREMT-Paramedic is not required to complete National EMS Certification Examinations.
- NREMT-Paramedics who submit an acceptable recertification application but do not include successful completion of a state-approved transition course from EMT-Paramedics to Paramedic will be issued National EMS Certification as an Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (NRAEMT) upon reaching their expiration date of March 31, 2016 or 2017.

EMS continuing education has been applied for through EMSI/DOH Bureau of EMS which is worth 50 hours of Medical/Trauma.

COST/TUITION

\$200.00 (which includes certification cards for AHA ACLS & PALS and ITLS). Payable the first day of class.

Pre-registration is recommended. Registration the day of the course will be accepted at all sites. Participant cancellation after registration may result in administrative fees thus reducing or eliminating potential refunds. ALL checks should be made payable to MUTUAL AID AMBULANCE SERVICE.
