- Classes are scheduled to run *Monday through Friday* from *08:30 to 12:30*. You should wear comfortable, but appropriate clothing.
- This certification program is a two-part certification process. The student will complete the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course and upon completion, will take a National Registry practical and computerized adaptive test (CAT) examination.
- Additional course requirements outlined in the National EMS Education Standards such as Hazardous Materials Awareness; Incident Command System (ICS 100) and NIMS 700 certifications will need to be satisfied prior to the National Registry CBT examination for EMR and EMT. EMT's have an additional requirement of completing 10 patient contacts to be eligible for testing.
- Students less than 18 years of age must have a parental consent form signed to sit for PA-State exam and are not eligible to test until they are 16 years old.
- Accepted candidates will receive a letter of acceptance. Students must have the necessary mental acuity, practical skills, motivation, and mental attitude and must adhere to the physical performance guidelines as outlined in the Functional Position Description for the EMT-Basic. In addition, the candidates must possess the perseverance to provide quality patient care, even under difficult circumstances.
- **Tuition**: EMT Course \$750.00 minimum deposit of \$150.00 due by the 1st day of class. Balance must be satisfied by the completion of the class and should be made payable to <u>Mutual Aid Ambulance Service</u> unless other arrangements have been made. Tuition includes EMT textbook, class materials, and required testing fees.
- Upon completion of the course, along with satisfaction of the required exams and financial responsibilities, the student will be considered eligible for the EMT National Registry written and practical testing. Completion of the program requirements does not guarantee successful completion of the written and psychomotor exam for the National Registry, or employment at Mutual Aid Ambulance Service, Inc.
